- Homestay support available 24 hours a day
- Host family will meet you at the airport or bus depot (and take you there on departure)
- Homestay placement
  - There may be up to two other students staying in the home (different nationality, same sex)
- Homestay with a Canadian family – at least one parent will be a native speaker of English.
- Homestay family will be located less than 30 minutes by bus from downtown near the school.
- Transport to/from school
  - Bus tickets will be; the host family will accompany students to and from school the first time
- Three meals a day plus snacks
- Internet access at home (for students bringing their own computer)
