### Halloween Holiday Program

#### Registration includes:

- Free drink and snack in the lunch room each morning
- Wireless internet access at school and use of the computer room at break time
- Use of school facilities such as the foos-ball, ping-pong and billiards tables
- Use of microwaves, fridges and other kitchen / lunchroom facilities
- Placement test and orientation on the first day
- Graduation certificates on the final day.

**Classes feature:**

- Native-speaker teachers with extensive qualifications and experience in teaching students of all ages and nationalities
- Focus on fluency – using English for effective communication
- Techniques and activities to make learning English fun!
- A wide range of nationalities in adult ESL program; custom classes for 11 – 14/15 year olds (English for Teens)

**Activities include:**

- Daily activities suitable for young teens, including sport, social, cultural and sightseeing activities.
- At least one experienced Activity Coordinator per 12 students (in addition to group's chaperone) for all activities; additional supervision is provided for certain activities (Monkido, swimming) to ensure student safety.
- Transportation and entry fees for all group members
- The possibility of other Stewart College students joining activities to increase cross-cultural exchange in English

**Homestay Includes:**

- Placement in a safe, supportive, English-speaking host family
- Three meals a day plus snacks (packed lunch on school days)
- Internet access at home, if students bring their own computer
- Pickup and drop off at Victoria bus depot

**Options:**

- Medical Insurance (\$2/day)
- Return airport transfer (\$110)
- Phone card (\$5.60)
- Custodianship by Randall Stewart, if required. \$100 including document notarization.

**Registration Requirements:**

- A non-refundable deposit equal to CAD\$200.
- The balance is due in full no less than 2 weeks prior to arrival.
