2007 Schedule

Stewart College of Languages is pleased to offer a range of programs for those wishing to learn another language or improve their proficiency in a foreign language.

A. Private individual, semi-private and private group classes.

Instruction in French, Spanish, Japanese, Italian is readily available. With a little notice, we can usually provide instruction in other languages as well.

Private and semi-private classes have a flexible schedule and are charged according to an hourly rate. Bring your friends to lower the rate!

- All scheduled classes must be paid for at the time of registration. Payment on the day is not permitted.
- Semi private classes (more than one student) must be paid for in one payment. Partial payments by individual members of the class are not permitted. The price given is the per-student price.
- Classes cancelled less than four business hours before the scheduled class, will not be rescheduled or refunded.
- Add GST to all fees except those for French language programs.

Private classes: \$45/hr (1 student)

Semi-Private classes: \$27/hr (2 students, each)
\$20/hr (3 students, each)
\$15/hr (4 students, each)
\$12/hr (5 or more students, each).

The following discounts apply:

- Register for 21-35 hours, receive a 5% discount.
- Register for 36-50 hours, receive a 10% discount.
- Register for 51+ hours, receive a 15% discount.

B. Tutoring for French Immersion school students.

- 3:45 – 4:45 p.m. on weekdays (flexible)
- \$12/hour, minimum 3 students registered for class to run
- Register for 21-35 hours, receive a 5% discount.

C. Group programs:

Part-time courses in languages other than English are held four times a year. Our foreign language classes focus on developing conversation skills in the chosen language. Grammar is taught as a means to achieving this objective, but the main focus of the class is improving students' speaking and listening skills.

- All classes focus on speaking and listening skills. In most cases, teachers are native speakers with extensive teaching experience.
- Minimum 5, maximum 12 students in a class.
- Each Saturday morning class is 2 hours long. Each evening class is 90 minutes long.
- A \$10 materials fee is charged for all courses except Beginner/Upper Beginner Spanish. The Spanish Beginner level textbook costs \$18.95 + GST. (Optional Audio CDs are available for \$19.95 + GST).
- Five students must register at least two weeks prior to the class start date for a particular class to run. Classes may be cancelled or rescheduled after the deadline date, depending on demand. Registering students are encouraged to let us know if an alternate class would also be suitable, in the event that there are not enough students for the preferred class.
- With the exception of complete beginners, levels will be checked after registration prior to class allocation.
- If a class has insufficient enrolment and is cancelled, refunds will be paid in full by the same method of payment within 30 days of the class being cancelled.
- Add GST to all fees except those for French language programs.

D. 2007 Summer Camps:



1. French Immersion for Grades 1 – 4

Students entering Grades 1 – 4 early French Immersion in September 2007, will benefit from these one or two-week morning camps. Students will play French language games, read stories, make crafts, prepare a play and sing songs. This is an ideal way to help your child brush up on their French speaking, listening and vocabulary before school starts. At the same time, they'll make friends, learn a lot about French language and culture, and they'll gain confidence in speaking French. Spaces are limited, register early!

Session 1: Monday to Friday, August 20 – 24, 9 a.m. – 12 p.m.

Session 2: Monday to Friday, August 27 – 31, 9 a.m. – 12 p.m.

COST: \$99 per child

2. French Immersion Fun and Games for Grades 1 – 4

In these afternoon one or two week camps, students entering Grades 1 – 4 early French Immersion in September 2007 will explore downtown Victoria in French. Activities include sports and games, a visit to the Petting Zoo, beach walks, visits to the Library, a visit to a grocery store, the Bug Zoo. All activities are facilitated and supervised by our French Immersion instructor to ensure students are exposed to, and encouraged to speak, as much French as possible.

Session 1: Monday to Friday, August 20 – 24, 1:00 – 4:00 p.m.

Session 2: Monday to Friday, August 27 – 31, 1:00 – 4:00 p.m.

COST: \$99 per child

3. French and Spanish Immersion for Adults

These one week full-time programs are designed to provide students with an intensive boost to their French or Spanish language skills. Classes will be grouped by language and student level and will focus on improving fluency and vocabulary.

Session 1: Monday to Friday, June 25 - 29, 9:00 – 3:00 p.m. (25 hours)

Session 2: Monday to Friday, July 9 - 13, 9:00 – 3:00 p.m. (25 hours)

Session 3: Monday to Friday, August 20 – 24, 9:00 – 3:00 p.m. (25 hours)

Session 4: Monday to Friday, August 27 – 31, 9:00 – 3:00 p.m. (25 hours)

COST: \$245 per session plus \$30 text/materials fee (add GST for Spanish)
